Health Guarantee and Contract

Your puppy is covered by a 2 year health guarantee, from its date of birth against serious life altering hip dysplasia, genetic eye diseases or genetic heart defects. It is the buyer's responsibility to maintain this dog in good health providing routine preventative health care including, but not limited to: regular vaccinations, internal, and external parasite control. Past veterinary records must be provided to the breeder for proof of routine preventative care and vaccinations in the event serious life altering hip dysplasia or genetic diseases of the eyes or heart should occur. This health guarantee contract is void if the dog is over weight or malnourished. The buyer also agrees to not exercise the puppy excessively until at least 6 months of age to prevent traumatic injury to the puppy's developing hips and bones. The buyer should feed the puppy quality large breed puppy food, and provide a nurturing environment free from abuse or neglect. It is highly recommended that new puppies are kept from playing and socializing with other dogs, and in areas frequented by other dogs until the puppy has had its complete regiment of vaccinations (generally around 16 weeks of age). This puppy is not intended for breeding purposes. This puppy must be spayed/neutered by 12 months of age and proof of this needs to be received by the seller by the puppy's 13 month birthday, or the health contract will be null and void.

In the event that serious life altering hip dysplasia, genetic eye diseases or genetic heart defects should occur, the buyer needs to contact the seller **prior** to any surgery or correction done on the dog. The buyer also needs to provide the seller with the following proof of the specific genetic disorder which has occurred: an OFA (Orthopedic Foundation for Animals) certification for hip dysplasia, an OFA certification for a genetic heart disorder, a CERF (Canine Eye Registration Foundation) exam certification for a genetic eye disease which the exam needs to be performed by a Veterinarian Ophthalmologist.

Warranties shall apply only to the original purchaser. Transfer of dog ownership shall void all provisions of this agreement. If this puppy develops any serious life altering hip dysplasia, genetic eye diseases, or genetic heart defects, seller agrees to replace this puppy with a new puppy from the next comparable litter. All shipping charges including crate, airline health certificate and cost of flight are the responsibility of the buyer. If you and your vet feel your dog can continue to live a happy life, I will give you a refund of \$500 to put towards vet expenses.

The buyer's signature below indicates that he/she has read, agrees and understands all the conditions of this health guarantee contract. This contract needs to be signed and mailed to the seller within 2 weeks of receiving their puppy, or the contract is void.
